The pterodactyl is from the pterosaur familly, corresponding to the Pterodactylus gender living in the Jurassic.

The fossils of some of these species are about 70 cm wingspan and pterodactyls lived there about 150 million years. They could have a fibrous crest on its head.

TYRANNOSAURUS




Tyrannosaurus rex is one of the largest land carnivores of all time. It from the tyrannosauridae familly, corresponding to the theropod gender.
